- <u>University of Illinois Urbana/Champaign</u> (seat currently held by Gary Gilpin): Election resulted in a tie. Waiting to hear results of draw.
- <u>Southern Illinois University Carbondale</u> (seat currently held by Shari Garnett): There are two individuals who completed the petition. The election is scheduled for November 18, 2021.
- <u>University of Illinois Chicago</u> (seats currently held by Lori Christopher and Mark Murphy): election is complete. Names of individuals elected is currently unknown.
- Governor's State University (seat currently held by Sheryl Jones Harper): No evidence of movement on election being held.
