Discussion and action on clarifying language for the pilot electronic voting/elections: We discussed Michael inserting a phrase in the bylaws indicating that in a purely electronic election there is no polling place because of the remote nature of voting from a computer, tablet, or cell phone. Election Day is not defined in the bylaws. Almost every election could be protested because electronic voting allows for the polling place to be anywhere.

Michael Pulley moved to insert the following phrase into the bylaws as the new item F: "For the purposes of electronic voting, the physical polling places shall not be recognized as it pertains to Article 2, Section 4, pre-election item 2". Current item F will become item G. Rick Marr seconded. A roll call vote was taken. Motion carried.
