HISTOLOGY TECHNOLOGIST

Function of Job

Under general supervision, performs a wide variety of standard and non-standard histological tests and examinations and a limited variety of new, modified, or special tests and examinations to provide data on the causes and/or progress of disease.

Characteristic Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. trims, processes, embeds and sections both hard and soft tissues of any size and condition from any part of the body, including, but not limited to, plant, and insect materials
- 2. prepares tissues for light microscopic study by developing and/or applying routine, histochemical and immunohistochemical stains and procedures which may require microscopic differentiation
- 3. examines all histochemical and immunohistochemical slides using a microscope; accepts or rejects slides on the basis of staining reactions
- 4. cuts and stains frozen sections for rapid diagnosis by a pathologist
- 5. prepares and maintains paraffin, reagents, and other solutions and stains according to standard formulas
- 6. maintains laboratory equipment
- 7. with appropriate supervision and guidance, performs tests and examinations which involve the application of new techniques and procedures
- 8. assists in the instruction of students and laboratory personnel in the principles and techniques of histologic tests and examinations
- 9. supervises subordinate laboratory personnel as assigned
- 10. properly disposes of toxic chemicals and reagents and practices basic laboratory safety
- 11. performs related duties as assigned
