Change-In-Title Policy requirement reflects revised procedures issued 12/23/03. The actions listed above are recommended. Based on job duties and responsibilities, positions should be identified and moved simultaneously to the appropriate new classifications.

## Voiding/Deleting Registers

The registers for the Dish Porter, Food Service Laborer, Kitchen Laborer, Kitchen Stores-Laborer and Pot-washing Machine Operator should be deleted at the close of business on September 30, 2005. All testing materials related to these titles should be destroyed. The new/revised class specifications and examining instruments for the Food Service Sanitation Laborer and Food Service Stores-Laborer will be effective October 1, 2005.

## Pay Rate/Ranges

Where necessary, employers should make adjustments to or establish new pay rates/ranges to accompany the above changes. In some instances, establishing a wide pay range will optimize the opportunity of each employer to properly reflect their individual compensation programs for these operations and positions.

## Seniority

Dependent upon on a change in classification, seniority calculations should be reviewed.
