Class Specification and Examination Components/Instruments

The new class specifications and examining instruments for the Carpenter series will be effective (available per E-Test) April 15, 2007. Pay Rate/Ranges

Where necessary, employers should make adjustments to or establish new pay rates/ranges to accompany the above changes. In some instances, establishing a wide pay range will optimize the opportunity of each employer to properly reflect their individual compensation programs for these operations and positions.

Seniority

Seniority calculations should be reviewed and established based on the final classification assignment.
