Consistent with our transition to electronic testing options, the State Universities Civil Service System (System Office) is proposing a revision to the classification plan for the Interpreter for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Series. Due to new State of Illinois requirements for the Interpreter for Deaf and Hard of Hearing occupational area, the System Office is updating the class specifications, specifically the Minimum Acceptable Qualifications, for the Interpreter for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Series. In addition, we plan to simply convert the current examinations to a Credentials Assessment model, which can be easily delivered in an electronic format. This conversion should prove to be more efficient and effective in addressing the applicant recruitment and employment components in this occupational area.

This proposal is to notify you of our planned conversion from the current Informational Supplement contained in this classification series to a Credentials Assessment format within our E-Test System. We do not plan to substantively revise the duties and responsibilities of the classification specifications for this series, but we will be minimally changing the Minimum Acceptable Qualifications of the class specification to coincide with Interpreter of Deaf Licensure Act of 2007. The proposed classification specification (with tracked changes) is attached for your review and comments. Confidential examination materials will be distributed later to meeting participants.
