Function of Job

Coordinates and/or performs duties necessary to order, re-order, maintain and inventory supplies and equipment necessary for providing patient care in a surgical service unit.

A Surgical Services Supplies and Equipment Worker typically provides service in areas of inventory/supplies and equipment maintenance/minor repair.

- 1. stocks, re-stocks, orders, receives, and returns inventory and supplies in accordance with established procedures
- 2. works with vendors to verify supplies have been ordered, to return damaged or inappropriate supplies, and to complete special supply orders when necessary
- 3. establishes/assists in establishing inventory of supplies according to established procedures and identified needs
- 4. maintains records of equipment sent to, borrowed from, or received from areas outside the Medical Center
- 5. maintains equipment inventory, usage, and location
- 6. orders and re-orders equipment; replaces or moves equipment
- 7. performs minor repairs on equipment as necessary
- 8. removes re-usable equipment from operating suites or rooms and returns to proper location for storage and cleaning
- 9. assembles new equipment when received based on included instructions
- 10. changes filters and coordinates the maintenance of other special equipment as necessary

- 11. prepares sterile supplies; cleans supplies, equipment, and sterile work areas
- 12. performs other related duties as assigned
