Voiding/Deleting Registers

The employment registers for the Electrician, Electrician Sub-Foreman, Electrician Foreman and the Crafts and Trades General Foreman classification(s) should remain intact and should not be voided.

Reemployment Registers

Upon utilization of CIT Policy #1, individuals on the Reemployment Register are entitled to remain on the Reemployment Register for the classification designated to replace the previous classification or for a classification that is reasonably equivalent to the previous classification specification and examination. Reemployment Registers shall not be voided.

Class Specification and Examination Components/Instruments

Applicants are allowed to bring and use the 2020 National Electrical Code (NEC) Handbook (hard copy) or a hard copy should be made available for the applicants to use while completing the Electrician and Electrician Sub-Foreman Knowledge Tests, effective May 1, 2022. Other manuals i.e., Ugly's Electrical Reference Book, IBEW NEA coins or reference materials including ElectriCalc Pro Electrical Calculator are NOT allowed for use with these examinations. The new class specification and edited examining instruments and Employment Guidelines for the Electrician and Electrician Sub-Foreman classification(s) will be effective (available per E-Test) on May 1st, 2022. Pay Rate/Ranges

Where necessary, employers should adjust or establish new pay rates/ranges to accompany the above changes. In some instances, establishing a wide pay range will optimize the opportunity of each employer to properly reflect their individual compensation programs for these operations and positions.

Seniority calculations shall be reviewed and established based on the final classification assignment.
