The following modifications are therefore incorporated into the State Universities Civil Service System classification plan.

The American Health Information Management Associate (AHIMA) announced changes to the current certification titles of the Registered Record Administrator (RRA) and the Accredited Record Technician (ART).

- Registered Record Administrator (RRA) →Registered Health Information Administrator (RHIA)
- Accredited Record Technician (ART) →Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT)

The Health Care Compliance Officer's registers shall remain intact and **shall not** be voided.

Class Specification and Examination Components/Instruments

The revised Class Specification for the Health Care Compliance Officer will be effective (available per our website) on **June 1, 2023**. Examination instruments will remain the same.
